tunate to train NFL players and celebrities over the years."

Seve's credentials were a good match for Diamante. "The chance to lead the club's fitness regime was a once in a lifetime opportunity," declared Seye. "Our wellness program is the most progressive in Cabo.

"I'm a proponent of functional training. Exercises that help you in your daily activities are a priority. I avoid use of one directional movements that isolate a single muscle," said Seve. "I start by teaching proper form and exercises that use your body weight as resistance. A healthier you is similar to building a house. You must have a strong foundation."

## STEADFASTNESS OF PURPOSE

Tiger's aim is to bring the same drive and dedication to golf course design as he has to playing the game during his storied career. He left Stanford University in 1996 to turn pro and, that year at the age of 20, he won twice on tour and netted \$940,000. His success earned him the Sports Illustrated Sportsman of the Year and PGA TOUR Rookie of the Year awards.

In the last 20 years, Tiger has won 105 tournaments, including 14 majors, and \$132 million in career earnings.

Utilizing his worldwide experience, Tiger Woods Design was launched to establish his mark as a golf course architect. "I've always loved the old, traditional layouts by MacKenzie, Ross, and Tillinghast," said Tiger. "My course

NAMING TIGER: Earl Woods, Tiger's father, a former Green Beret, served two tours in the Vietnam War and was awarded a Vietnamese Silver Star for bravery. Earl was assigned as an advisor to Lt. Colonel Nguyen Phong, a deputy province chief in command during the Vietnam War. They developed a deep respect for one another. Earl had Nguyen's back, and Nguyen had Earl's back. Earl's nickname was Woody, and Nguyen's nickname was Tiger. After the Vietnam War, Earl tried unsuccessfully to locate Nguyen (he starved to death in a "re-education" camp). In honor of Nguyen, who fearlessly protected him in battle, Earl named his first son "Tiger."
