PUNTA CANA, DOMINICAN REPUBLIC: The Web.com Tour, the PGA TOUR's developmental circuit, is the dominate pathway for players to earn their Tour card. At year end, the top 25 players on the Web.com Tour money list are given PGA TOUR credentials for the next season. The pressure is intense and competition is fierce for the right to compete for over \$330 million in annual PGA TOUR prize money. New in 2016 to the Web.com tournament schedule is the *Corales Puntacana Resort & Club Championship, June 2-5*.

Republic), The Westin Puntacana Resort & Club, and a three-mile powdery sand beach. Its privately owned Punta Cana International Airport (PUJ) handles flights from 28 countries and 96 cities, has 28 nonstop flights and 6.5 million passengers each year.

"Golf is an important industry in The Dominican Republic," explained Frank Elias Rainieri, COO of Grupo Puntacana. "It is exciting for us at Puntacana Resort & Club to host the Corales Puntacana Resort & Club Championship. Growing golf in the Dominican Republic is very important for golf and for Puntacana. Our involvement helps set the stage for the next generation of players. We hope our country will one day bring new players to the PGA TOUR." ■
