

**Stock Farm** offers experiences as vast as Montana's landscape.

HAMILTON, MONTANA: Since the 1880s, 26 U.S. Presidents have served office (16 Republicans and 10 Democrats). During that same period, only two stakeholders have owned the land surrounding Stock Farm, an exclusive private community in the Bitterroot Valley.

"I can understand why the land carries such value," said Tom Fazio. "The first night at Stock Farm, I came to appreciate the meaning of Big Sky Country. I felt like I was on top of the world, an inspirational feeling I have never experienced anyplace else. Stock Farm is a storybook kind of place."

Marcus Daly, known as one of the three Copper Kings of Montana, discovered the state's riches extended beyond silver mining. Shrewd business deals allowed him to accumulate vast land holdings for his copper mining operations. By 1890, Daly was one of the richest

men on Wall Street and developed the town of Hamilton, Montana, into an executive retreat and hunting camp. Daly invested some of his wealth into horse breeding at his Bitterroot Stock Farm, and in 1897, produced the only thoroughbred, born in Montana, to win the Belmont Stakes.

## PASSING THE BATON

A century later, Charles Schwab and Jim Schueler partnered to build an ultra-exclusive private community on Daly's farm, and in homage of the land's history, named it Stock Farm. The 2,600-acre, golf-based retreat is near Hamilton, Montana. The centerpiece is a Tom Fazio designed golf course and a rustic 27,000 square-foot log cabin clubhouse. Other amenities include a spacious equestrian center and 30 miles of mountain trails.




Wildlife is an important part of life at the community. Stock Farm is located on the ancestral wintering grounds for great elk herds. Some 500 of these magnificent animals live on-site. Also nearby is the Bitterroot River, teeming with rainbow and brown trout.

"The clubhouse required 16 semi-truckloads of logs, all handcrafted on-site," detailed Schueler. "There was no standard frame, everything was custom. If you have ever lived in a log cabin home, odds are you never want to go back to the cold, sterile feel of drywall. Log cabin construction creates a certain warmth."

Stock Farm's financial footing is sound, it is member owned, and this fall it will break ground on a new pool and fitness center. The membership is growing and its Legacy Membership, which offers privileges to your extended family, makes the value proposition compelling.

"I like to say, where we live, we live close to the world. We live in Montana at Stock Farm," said Schueler.
