SAN MARTIN, CALIFORNIA: Rosewood CordeValle is located on 1,700 acres of rolling foothills of the Santa Cruz Mountains. It features 45 luxurious accommodations, a Sense spa, three distinct restaurants, four plexicushion tennis courts, meeting space, and an on-site working vineyard and winery. Its Robert Trent Jones Jr. golf course has unobstructed views of Northern California's hillsides, canyons, and meadows.

"The resort is a 60-mile drive from Pebble Beach," said Robert Trent Jones Jr. "In my opinion, there are very few reasons to leave the Monterey Peninsula for golf. CordeValle is the exception. The setting is stirring, punctuated by hundreds of majestic old oak trees. I utilize cross hazards in the fairways to keep you thinking off the tee."

Rosewood CordeValle's list of accolades is impressive.

The resort hosted the PGA TOUR Frys.com Open for four years, *Golfweek* rates the course No. 4 in California, and *Golf Digest* ranks it No. 44 in the country. Its spa received a Forbes Four-Star Award and *U.S. News* considers it No. 10 on its list of Best Hotels in California. It now has another honor to boast: Site of a USGA Major.

The United States Women's Open Golf Championship, one of thirteen national championships conducted by the USGA, is the oldest of the LPGA Tour's five major championships. Established 70 years ago in 1946, the U.S. Women's Open is the only event to have been recognized as a major by the LPGA since the group's founding in 1950.

"The San Francisco area has a rich history of hosting USGA championships, and the USGA was proud to add to that tradition with the U.S. Women's Open at CordeValle this past July," said Thomas O'Toole Jr., VP and Chairman of the USGA Championship Committee. "The competition was a mental test as much as it was a physical test." ■

Traveling to CordeValle: The resort is 60 minutes from the San Francisco airport (SFO), a 45-minute drive from Pebble Beach, and 35 minutes from San Jose.

CordeValle's Ultimate Golf Package includes one night in a luxurious bungalow, one round of golf with cart, and continental breakfast. Rates start at \$495/night (single) and \$640/night (double).

Who is the only amateur to win the U.S. Women's Open?

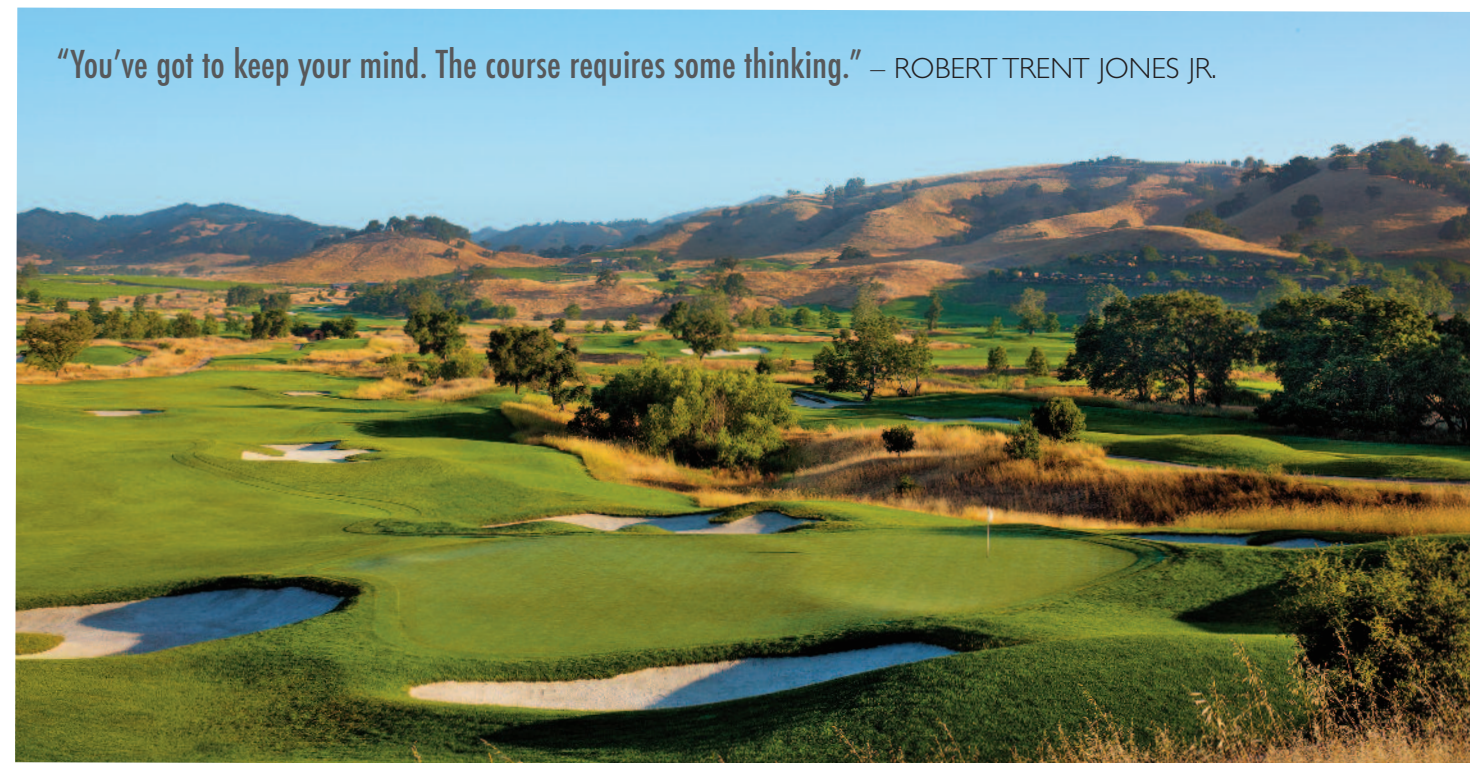
Catherine Lacoste, a French amateur, edged Susie Maxwell-Berning and Beth Stone by two strokes in 1967.
