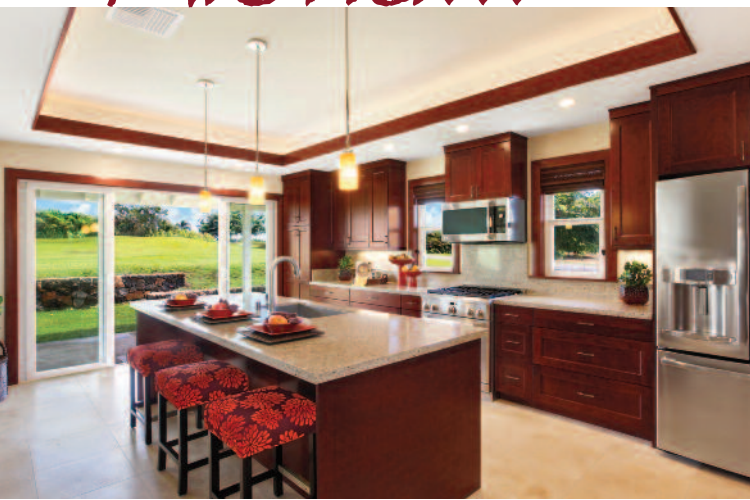

Wai'ula'ula, at Mauna Kea Resort on the Big Island of Hawaii, and Emerald Homes at Wainani in Poipu on the island of Kauai, are two of D.R. Horton's ocean-view communities known for their quality homes, great views, and wealth of resort amenities.

Goldilocks climates. Both Wai'ula'ula on the Big Island and Wainani on Kauai are located on the leeward side of the islands, providing predictable sunny weather conditions."

IN A CLASS OF ITS OWN

When tycoon Laurance Rockefeller opened Mauna Kea Beach Hotel on a desolate, crescent-shaped sandy beach, the road from the Kona Airport to the hotel wasn't completely paved. Guests traversed the rugged Kawaihae Highway, built by the military, in the highlands of the island.

Along the Kohala Coast sits Wai'ula'ula at The Mauna Kea Resort. Nestled near Mauna Kea Beach, Wai'ula'ula offers resort living with upscale comfort. Floor plans were built with entertainment in mind, with indoor and outdoor spaces blending effortlessly. Three-bedroom, three-bath villas and four-bedroom, four-bath estate homes offer a choice to fit your family's needs.

Residents have access to a new recreation pavilion, complete with an infinity pool, keiki (children's) pool, hot tub, fitness center, and a BBQ courtyard. The pool clubhouse is equipped with a kitchen, a large, flat-screen TV, and ample seating.

Tucked away in the secluded slopes and fairways of nationally ranked Mauna Kea and Hapuna golf courses, Wai'ula'ula offers preferred access and additional membership options not available to the public.

FIVE MILLION YEARS AND COUNTING

Kauai is the oldest island in the Hawaiian chain. Wainani, an Emerald Homes community, is located along the fairways of Kiahuna Golf Club within the resort community of Poipu Beach on the sunny South Shore of Kauai.

Respected golf course architect, Robert Trent Jones II, deftly included ancient remnants of an authentic Hawaiian village and Hawaiian archeological historical sites (including blind spider caves in a small outcrop of lava tubes on hole No. 2) into his design.

Homes, designed by renowned local architect Philip "Pip" White of Philip White Architects, include vaulted ceilings leading to covered lanai spaces where compelling golf course, mountain, and ocean views prevail.

Home features include porcelain floors at entry and in kitchen and baths, concealed split system air conditioning, gas tankless water heating systems, and dual pane Low-E windows.

For the gourmet home cook, kitchens boast coffered ceilings and solid surface countertops.

Niceties in the master bedrooms include walk-in wardrobe closets and soaking tubs. ■
