"When other private clubs matched our facilities, we took the experience to another level," said Rudd. "As a member-owned community with funded reserves and no debt, we're able to provide services most clubs charge for or are non-existent. For example, we offer complimentary breakfast each morning; have a strict no tipping policy;

include roving 24-hour security and paramedic staff; notary service; dry cleaning pick-up; a club sommelier; and hurricane preparation, shelter, and post cleanup assistance."

Frenchman Creek's Beach Club is located on Celestial Way, about a seven-minute drive from the golf clubhouse. "The street name Celestial seems appropriate and symbolic," expressed Cindy Teyssedou, manager of the Beach Club. "We offer a 'supremely good' time.

"We take the hassle out of going to the beach. Only a swimsuit is obligatory," teased Teyssedou. "Private valet



parking is offered and all the necessities for a day on the surf-and-sand are included. We have you covered, with everything from towels, sunscreen, beach chairs, umbrellas, goggles, and complimentary snacks. Even the raised boardwalk to the beach is carpeted to keep your feet cool. After a day of play, don't fret if you have an appetite since we have a full service restaurant serving gourmet fare."
