STREAMSONG, FLORIDA: Built on a former Mosaic Company phosphate mine in central Florida, Streamsong Resort's 16,000 acres are punctuated with dramatic elevation changes, abundant lakes, and 15 million cubic yards of sand—a sharp contrast to the rest of Central Florida's relatively flat topography. As its Red and Blue courses have gained wide acclaim, the resort has quickly earned a reputation as a "must play."

"I salute Mosaic for their vision," stated Bill Coore, co-designer of the Red Course. "Their decision to build Streamsong continued to support the area, create jobs, drive its economic engine, and develop one of the world's best golf destinations. In the early days of planning, many thought the idea of the resort was a wild idea. Today, the resort merits a visit. You will not be disappointed."

This fall, Streamsong's twosome becomes a threesome with the opening of its Black Course, designed by Gil Hanse. "It is an eye-popping layout with rolling terrain, sand, and vistas which are reminiscent of the Sand Belt of Australia," described Hanse.

Streamsong's 216-room lodge and 12-room club-

house showcase the property's natural environment. The lodge guest rooms feature floor-to-ceiling windows and offer an unusual way for guests to truly relax—a library of hand-selected books. AcquaPietra, the resort's 7,000-square-foot, grotto-style spa, is a metaphor for the prehistoric seas that once covered the region.

"Once here, few wander off property," said Richard Mogensen, general manager. "This allows for cohesion and privacy for your buddies group, wedding, or corporate meeting. Our golf courses have earned such accolades, the wealth of other activities is easily overlooked. Our *sporting clays* allow you to shoot over a variety of ravine landscapes, you can *bass fish* with nary another boat in sight, and our *archery guides* will fit you with an advanced recurve bow and provide instruction.
