"We recently completed a multi-million dollar renovation with special attention paid to expand and upgrade our practice facility," said Jeff Goren, golf course superintendent.

"This will be my 17th season at Mirabel and I could clearly see the aftermath and wear and tear with increased usage," continued Goren.

"We enlarged the teeing area on both ends of the range, added an uneven lie zone for specialized chip shots, and installed outdoor speakers for music to match your taste. We even clustered sprinkler heads closer together to provide greater watering flexibility to foster quicker repair of divots."

Over the summer, fresh Augusta white sand was placed in all bunkers.

"The combination of colors is remarkable," smiled Goren. "The hues of our desert's natural vegetation, lush green fairways, and brilliant sandy bunkers moves you. I know we accomplished our job, when, on a 100+ degree afternoon, my nine-year-old daughter riding around with me inquired, 'Dad, why is there snow on the course when it's so hot out?"
