HAMILTON, BERMUDA: At 21 square miles long, Bermuda is a small island with big adventure. Not only is it famous for its shorts, pink-sand beaches, and oceanfront championship golf courses, but also for all that you can experience on the island.

BERMUDA has one of the highest concentrations of golf per square mile in the world.

Above ground, rent a pedal bike to explore the rich, flora-filled landscapes along the 18-mile Railway Trail or uncover historic military might at Bermuda's impressive forts. For a unique view of the island, hop on a jet ski and discover tough-to-get-to gems: secluded beaches, hidden coves, and sunken ships.

Located 650 miles east of North Carolina, or about a two-hour flight from most East Coast cities, Bermuda is an international getaway with a pleasant four-season climate that is full of island adventure. ■
