six dining facilities, the Cosmo & Company Spa, a resort-style pool, and state-of-the-art fitness and tennis facilities that were ranked No.1 in the country by the USTA (with 22 courts including pickleball and a 500-seat stadium venue).

"We have been careful to preserve our heritage as one of South Florida's premier golf facilities," proudly reported Fitzherbert. "Over the past decade, more than \$75 million in expansions and enhancements have been completed, including capital earmarked for our three golf courses. In recent years, we have renovated our East and North courses and later this spring, we are slated to begin a renovation of our South Golf Course by legendary architect Rees Jones."
