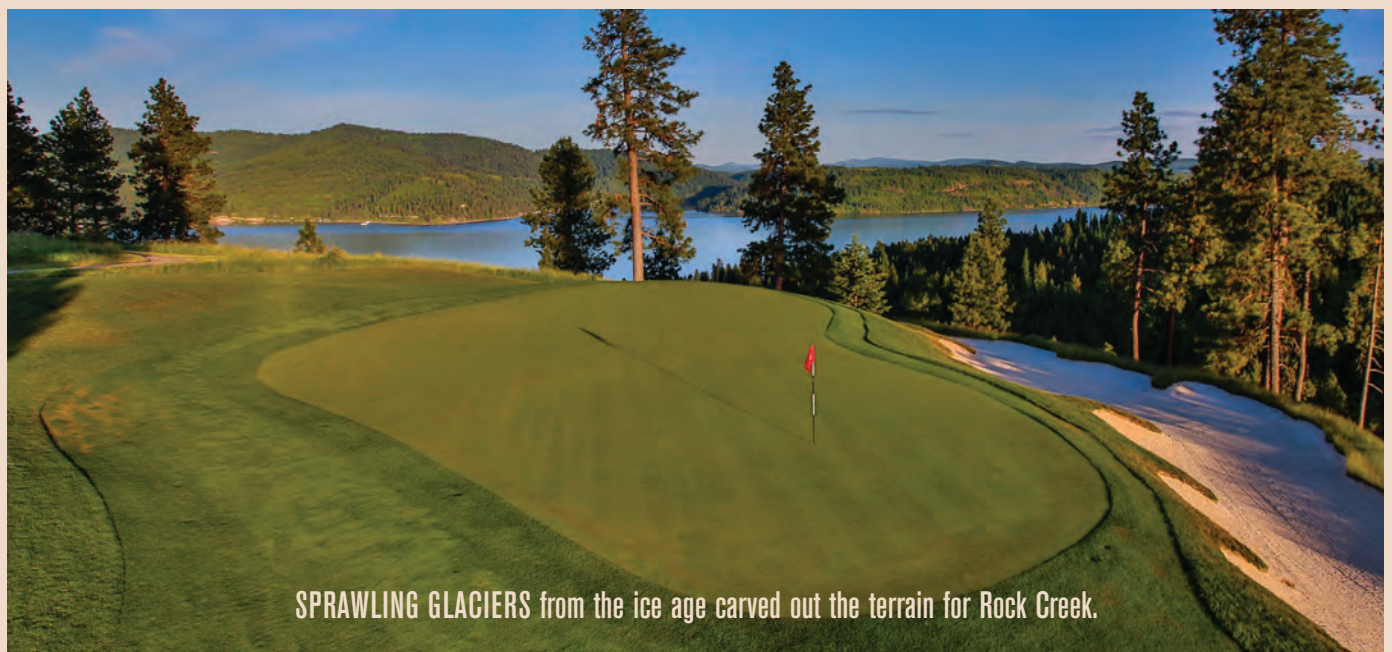
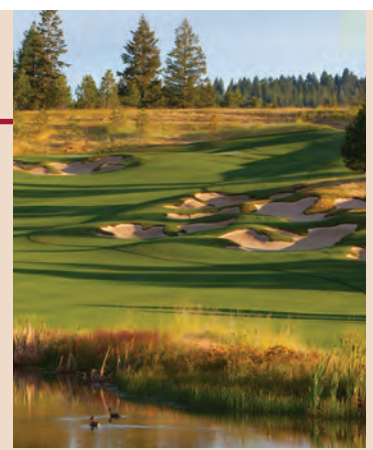

During the summer, Lake Coeur d’Alene (named one of the top six lakes in the world by National Geographic) is a hub of activity.”

The Club at Rock Creek is a private community with a Tom Weiskopf designed golf course, expansive practice facility, a dog park, nature trails, and sports courts. An added member benefit includes access to 18 Foley winer-

ies in the Pacific Northwest, California, and New Zealand. Compared to other exclusive golf clubs in the region, Rock Creek is an affordable option to consider with smartly designed homes on spectacular view property within an amenity-rich gated community. Prices start in the \$800s and smaller townhomes are coming soon.
