

## The Club at Ibis THE TRIPLE CROWN OF NICKLAUS FAMILY DESIGNED GOLF

In the past four years, the private community has invested more than \$42 million in member amenities, including a new Clubhouse, Sports Village, and a new Jack Nicklaus Signature Course.

WEST PALM BEACH, FLORIDA: In course design, as in professional golf, Jack Nicklaus blazed a trail for others to follow. "My interest in design started in the 1960s," remembered Nicklaus. "Pete Dye asked for my input on what would become The Golf Club in Columbus, Ohio. I realized it really interested me."

The Club at Ibis is the only private community that can boast three Nicklaus family designed golf courses: the Legend, the Heritage, and the Tradition, created by Jack Nicklaus Sr., Jack Nicklaus Jr., and Steve Nicklaus. "I think it's kind of special that the three of us designed golf courses in the same community," said Jack Nicklaus. "Each stands on its own."

The Golden Bear recently renovated the Legend Course at Ibis, a course he designed 28 years ago—the same year he won the U.S. Senior Open and PGA Seniors Championship.

"The game and my design philosophy have evolved. In 1991, we were playing with wooden woods and balata balls," said Nicklaus. "Now, with my redesign complete, it matches today's modern equipment benefits. Although the course is longer, the bailout areas are more generous. My advice, that has served me well over the years, is don't try shots beyond your capability and play the set of tees that matches your handicap."

The Club at Ibis has over 1,800 homes in 33 beautiful neighborhoods with golf villas from \$150,000 to estate homes over \$2 million. Members have access to the Sports Village and Clubhouse complex, and 16 Har-Tru tennis courts with sub-surface irrigation systems. It is located 20 minutes from every modern convenience. Palm Beach International Airport (PBI) is to the south and the Gardens Mall, Kravis Center, and beaches of Singer Island are due east. The international equestrian communities of Wellington are just off to the west.
