

From March 23-29, 2020, the world's best PGA TOUR players will compete at The Corales Puntacana Resort & Club Championship.

PUNTA CANA, DOMINICAN REPUBLIC: Corales, designed by Tom Fazio at Puntacana Resort & Club, is a dramatic 18-hole course with six Caribbean oceanside holes.

Set alongside natural cliffs, bays, ocean coves, inland lakes, and coralina quarries, Corales rates among the world's best. The exhilarating challenge culminates playing Devil's Elbow—the final three holes—including the striking 18th hole with its dramatic forced carry over the cliff lined Bay of Corales.

Those looking for more than a week of fun under the sun should consider its attached residential community with a private enclave of luxurious homes and golf-view estate homesites. Membership opportunities includes special perks at Tortuga Bay Hotel, The Westin Puntacana Resort & Club, and access to Punta Cana International Airport's private VIP Terminal (the resort owns the airport).





In addition to Corales, guests have access to La Cana Golf Club, with three nine-hole P.B. Dye designs (Tortuga, Hacienda, and Arrecife) that have a combined 14 holes with ocean views. La Cana Golf Club was the first course in the Caribbean to utilize paspalum grass, for its superior playing conditions. Not surprisingly, *Golf Magazine* has compared it to Pebble Beach and rates it the "Number One Course in the Caribbean."
