Berkeley Hall Club is the lowest density private golf community in the Southeast.

BLUFFTON, SOUTH CAROLINA: Berkeley Hall Club, located minutes from the causeway to Hilton Head Island, is named after Lord Berkeley, one of five British generals awarded land holdings in the New World by the King of England more than a century before America was founded.

“It’s easy to understand the appeal of our location,” stated Adam Kushner, director of golf operations. “We have one of the most peaceful settings you can imagine. As you gaze at our ever-changing landscape, depending on the tide, you may be looking at oyster beds, native grasses, or with a little luck, catch a glimpse of dolphins frolicking in the water.”

Membership at Berkeley Hall includes access to a Jeffersonian-style clubhouse, two Fazio courses, a spa and fitness center, a six-court tennis complex, the River Park with 19 docks, 10 miles of nature trails, and 28 guest cottages.

“Our Golf Learning Center is the crown jewel of our 33-acre practice facility,” continued Kushner. “Four climate-controlled hitting bays allow you to hone your game, no matter the time of year.

“We are particularly proud of our putting surfaces,” concluded Kushner. “A steady putter can make the difference between a good day and a bad day. The greens on both of our courses can roll up to 13 on the Stimpmeter [not far off what typical playing conditions are at any U.S. Open site]. During The HAIG (HardAsItGets) Member-Member, our pin locations aren’t for the faint at heart. Fortunately, the scramble format provides a bit of leeway between teammates.” ■
