DAUFUSKIE ISLAND, SOUTH CAROLINA: For more than 25 years, Pew Research Center has been a leader in tracking demographics in America. Their latest report on community interaction revealed only 31 percent of us know our neighbors.

In addition to its Rees Jones designed golf courses, Haig Point offers complete equestrian facilities, a beach club, fitness center, lighted tennis courts, a kids camp, a dog park, and one mile of private beach. “We are one of the few places in the world where you can arrive to our boarding stables and be horseback riding on a secluded stretch of coastline within minutes,” lauded Egly.

A mix of townhouses and estate homes are available to match your usage. “Our Plantation Homes are the ultimate lock-and-leave option, while Freeport Drive is Haig Point’s equivalent of Rodeo Drive in Beverly Hills,” reported Adam Martin, vice president of sales and marketing. “With ultra high-speed Internet installed community wide, telecommuting to work is a viable option,” said Martin. “Ferries run every hour, so one day delivery of your Amazon packages or groceries from Instacart are seamless.

“Our setting provides the ultimate in privacy and security. Recently, we closed a resale and the resident did not have a front door key upon transfer. Simply put, they never had a need for it,” concluded Martin. ■
