The Frederica Farms, a resident community garden, is home to a colony of 40,000 honeybees.



Frederica’s 425 acres of interconnected lakes create the largest freshwater lake in Coastal Georgia. Its tabby and timber frame boathouse is built in the Adirondack style and offers members access to electric-powered watercraft, including a 30-foot Elko for cruises of up to 12 passengers.
