LOS CABOS, MEXICO: The Baja Peninsula is a sliver of land that runs parallel to Mexico’s northwest coast with Cabo San Lucas sitting at the southern-most point on the Baja. About a 20-minute drive from the international airport is Querencia, an exclusive private 2,000 acre community anchored by an award-winning Tom Fazio design that defines private golf in the region.

“It’s never been difficult to entice people to come to Los Cabos,” said Tom McCloskey, owner and principal partner of Querencia. “Our community is positioned as an option for those who desire large, open spaces and the flexibility to gather for extended periods of time.”

GROWTH AND EXPANSION

Querencia is currently in talks with Tom Fazio to explore the addition of *another* 18-hole course to the community.

Over \$200 million has been invested in Querencia’s growth in recent years and according to CEO and partner Jorge Carrera, this is just the beginning.

“Our approach includes creating attractive residential opportunities—like our Beach Club and Ocean Residences (opening in Spring, 2023)—to expanding our golf options,” said Carrera.

In addition, Querencia’s hiking and biking trails have expanded to more than 12 miles with incredible views to the Sea of Cortez and surrounding mountains.

“Much of Querencia has been carved into the existing landscape, respecting the surrounding environment. It serves a niche in the Cabo market, delivering the best of a private lifestyle,” expressed Tom Fazio. “Querencia was a wild piece of land to tame. The end result is a spectacular course with even more spectacular views. Its central location only adds to its appeal.”

NOURISHING THE MIND, BODY, AND SPIRIT

“Our speaker series has been well received,” detailed Carrera. “It’s an inspiring collection of thought leaders, authors, politicians who come to Querencia to share their stories and interact with our members.”

The club recently completed El Santuario, a multipurpose space for yoga and meditation. “The overall experience at Querencia remains our priority,” said Carrera. “A purchased 50-foot custom Fountaine Pajot motorized catamaran, exclusively for member use, is further proof of our commitment to make Querencia the most well-rounded experience in all of the Baja.” ■
