

TRUMP NATIONAL DORAL

Where History and Legends Are Made

MIAMI, FLORIDA: With much fanfare, Trump National Doral reopened several years ago after a \$250 million top-to-bottom reimagination. "Continual improvement is a core value. From increasing the size of numerous lakes to transplanting 400 trees, anything that enhances the guest experience is considered," expressed Trent Kathmann, director of golf.

With four championship caliber courses, the property has a wind in its sails. "We have been quick to adapt to changing times," continued Kathmann. "I think our results speak for themselves. New members joining the club have significantly increased; our tee sheets are robust, and as travel returns, our hotel occupancy is vibrant."

One of Trump National Doral's greatest assets is its close proximity to Miami International Airport, providing nonstop access to 150 worldwide cities. "If you walked the 36 holes of the Red Tiger and the Golden Palm courses with your caddie, it would equal the distance reaching the main terminal, and you would burn almost 1,000 calories to boot!" noted Kathmann.

THE RETURN OF CHAMPIONSHIP GOLF

With the Red Tiger, the Golden Palm, the Silver Fox, and the Blue Monster courses, Trump National Doral has been a must visit for the golf purist. "Each design has a distinguishing feature," critiqued Kathmann. "On the Red Tiger, water comes into play on 17 holes. Consider it an achievement if you finish your round with the same ball

you teed off with. Bunkering characterizes the Golden Palm, and the Silver Fox offers a little bit of everything and is considered a favorite by many of our members."

In late October, the inaugural season ending LIV Invitational will be contested on the Blue Monster. "Without question, the Blue Monster set in motion stellar growth of the town of Doral just outside our resort's entranceway," said Kathmann. "For 55 years, the course hosted the best golfers around the world. I think we are a perfect venue for LIV. Even if the wind is calm, conditions can be challenging and we have created a setting that on-site fans will enjoy. As you watch the conclusion of play on the 18th green, with the American flag prominently waving in the background, you can't help but be filled with emotion." ■
