ANGUILLA IS KNOWN AS A DESTINATION OF LUXURY for its pristine beaches and reliable tropical weather. However, direct access to the island was limited. Most would fly into St. Maarten then travel via boat for the 35-minute trip to Anguilla’s Blowing Point Ferry Terminal. Now, Aurora Anguilla offers fairly priced non-stop air charter service on Embraer 170s from White Plains, New York, and Fort Lauderdale, Florida, into nearby AXA (Anguilla’s Clayton J. Lloyd Airport). The flights are operated by Best Jets International.
