A Passion to Protect

Santa Lucia Preserve is a landscape of unspeakable beauty.

CARMEL, CALIFORNIA: Nine miles away from Pebble Beach Resort (via the scenic 17 Mile Drive) is Santa Lucia Preserve, a 20,000-acre, conservation-minded community that’s an innovative model for how both man and nature can thrive. Along with a spectacular Tom Fazio-designed golf course, equestrian facilities, a trail system spanning nearly 100 miles, fully equipped Sports and Aquatic Center, and water sports on 18-acre Moore’s Lake, Santa Lucia Preserve boasts 31 square miles of oak woodlands, savannas, grass-lands, wetlands, redwood forests, and Monterey pine that rise from 100 to 3,000 feet above sea level. Its diverse habitats are virtually hidden from outside view by the surrounding ridges of the Santa Lucia Range.

“Our members and guests often comment that our ‘driveway’ is one of the most beautiful and serene drives in golf,” said Jen Anello, director of sales at Santa Lucia Preserve. “Members wind through diverse landscapes, enjoy wildlife sightings, and experience the climate change from cooler coastal temperatures at the Main Gate to sunshine and warmer temps at The Preserve Golf Club.”

To put Santa Lucia Preserve’s size into perspective, the low-density, member-owned community is larger than the entire Monterey Peninsula. More than 300 wildlife species use this magnificent setting as a corridor from the mountains to the sea. In order to protect its “light footprint,”

90 percent of the land was placed into a non-profit, independent conservancy to maintain the land in perpetuity.

The Preserve’s commitment to conservation and sustainability also extends to The Preserve Golf Club. “We are one of the first in the nation to install floating solar panels on one of our golf course water storage ponds,” said Anello. “The system generates clean electricity and reduces water evaporation during the warmer summer months.”

The Preserve Golf Club annually hosts a full slate of member events, as well as prestigious amateur and collegiate golf tournaments. The club also features a new state-of-the-art practice facility including a multiple tee driving range, short game area, target greens, and wedge zone.

“Imagine driving through a pristine natural wonderland, arriving at your club in the warm sunshine, to enjoy an unhurried round of golf with friends,” said Anello. “The abundance of nature, diverse offering of events and activities, and convenient location to Pebble Beach and Carmel-by-the-Sea all set The Preserve apart from its seaside neighbors.”

While limited real estate opportunities are available at The Preserve, the club now offers non-resident golf memberships by invitation, where real estate purchases are not required. ■
