The course transitions dramatically to a different landscape on the back nine, where a links-style course set on a distinct peninsula offers a thrilling challenge. The stark contrast is like a journey between two different worlds, leaving players with an unforgettable experience.



A RELAXED ENVIRONMENT

The Ford’s 250-acre golf course, created with its members in mind, invites golfers to make their game more or less challenging by either shooting in line with the pin across bunkers or hitting the ball away from trouble. Better yet, picking up an impromptu game is easy thanks to no tee times, so golfers can sink into an unhurried game nearly any time of day. “Our members love the easy, casual and relaxed environment they get when playing here,” said Ryan Skipton, director of golf at The Ford. “It’s always easy to get a game.”

WHERE NATURE PLAYS

“The true experience here at The Ford is not just about the golf course and playing golf. It’s also about making connections to the setting and the wildlife,” shared Skipton. Akin to the laidback lifestyle at The Ford, the course immerses players in an experience that’s as much a sport as it is a wildlife tour.
