

Bridging the Generational Divide

with tennis, pickleball, basketball, volleyball, and bocce courts; a 28-foot climbing wall; and a teen center with ping pong, billiards, video games, and jukebox; and (3) a water park with a lazy river, three water slides, a lagoon with zero-entry access, and gourmet food trucks. Without a doubt, Aurora Anguilla poses to become the premier family activity complex in the Caribbean."

Aurora International Golf Club, designed by Greg Norman, offers unobstructed views of St. Martin and the Caribbean Sea. Avalon Links is the resort's 9-hole short course, featuring double greens and a drivable par-4.

"I took prevailing trade winds into account. Hitting into a headwind or crosswind is one of the most difficult shots in golf," advised Greg Norman. "My tip? Start with a solid foundation and take a light grip to help you make a rhythmic, free-flowing swing into the wind."
