LAS VEGAS STRIP, NEVADA: Even the most seasoned gambler would be jealous of the city's winning streak. Shortly after the Las Vegas Raiders made the Allegiant Stadium their home, the Las Vegas Golden Knights moved into T-Mobile Arena. Now, there are rumblings the Tropicana may repurpose as the site for a future Oakland Athletics ballpark.

"We boast the only bet in Vegas you can't lose," grinned Canetti. "Make a wager to hit the green on No. 9 and you get 150 percent of your money in golf shop script. If you miss, you get a credit for the exact amount of your wager."

"The course has matured beautifully," commented Canetti. "We are particularly proud of our conditioning and player-friendly design. Our waste areas are banked to feed errant shots back into the fairways, and our agronomy crew recently purchased Ninja Tines equipment that is quickly becoming the benchmark for non-disruptive green aerification. You literally will be hard pressed the following day to notice the greens have been aerified." ■
