Building the resort required several steps not required

on the mainland. First, a team of archeologists searched the site, and then engineers evaluated the land to map any lava tubes bisecting the area. Once the land was cleared for heavy construction, the top layer of lava was removed to uncover dense lava rocks with a gray/blue hue, buried five to ten feet below. Those lava rocks were excavated, and are now the majestic lava walls scattered throughout the property.


