JUPITER, FLORIDA: A club with one golf course is known as a golf community. If it has two courses, it’s known as a golf facility; however, those with three-member courses (a rarity) are a golf destination.

Jonathan’s Landing is a private, member-owned club. Its stability, service-centric attitude, and support of local causes solidified its brand as one of the top clubs in Florida. Members have access to three courses, 10 Har Tru tennis courts, six pickleball courts, the 13,000-square-foot Fitness & Spa Center (with Technogym equipment), walking trails, parks, and a variety of dining venues.

“Alcoa was the original developer,” reported Joe DiPasquantonio, general manager. “The community was so successful that they purchased a vast tract of land 20 minutes to our west to build two additional courses. The
