More than \$32 million was invested to transform Bali Hai from a vacant scrubland. "The design feeds your ball toward the fairway, but make no mistake, properly placed tee balls are required to score. We do have rough to frame the fairways, but by no means is it like Oakmont Country Club in Pennsylvania [host to the 2025 U.S. Open]," detailed Alex Canetti, director of sales at Bali Hai.

The Southern Nevada Hotel Concierge Association (SNHCA) is dedicated to providing the highest level of



assistance to visitors in Las Vegas. Its principal mission is to set a standard in a city known for service. Bali Hai Golf Club, for over 10 years, has been awarded "Best Course in Town" by the SNHCA.
