nity that brings new opportunities every day," said Linderman. "Our members aren't just residents—they're part of a lifestyle that inspires, engages, and brings people together all year long."

Often called a "cruise ship on land," Boca West's campus reflects its members' diverse interests—from culinary and cultural to fitness and fashion. With over 600 annual events, the social calendar mirrors the community's energy, a reflection of Linderman's belief that programming should be as personalized as the members.

Over the past decade, Boca West has invested \$250 million in facilities, with another \$95 million approved—all without a single member assessment.

"Our long-range plan reflects a desire to exceed expectations at every turn. As the phrase from *Field of Dreams* goes: 'If you build it, they will come,'" added Linderman.

This summer, pickleball courts expanded from 14 to 25. Last year, the Lifestyle & Racquet Center debuted its five-pool Aquatic Center, two new dining venues, bringing the total to eight, and a 72,000-square-foot Fitness Center. It also introduced a family game lounge, an Art and Epicurean Studio, and Market Square (a gourmet grab-and-go market with curated selections, fresh coffee, and house-made specialties).
