WHAT’S IN A NAME

The name Bone Valley is deeply rooted in the history of the land itself. Millions of years ago, much of Florida was underwater, and the region became known for its rich deposits of prehistoric marine fossils, including shark teeth and other ancient bones that were regularly unearthed during the area’s mining era. “While we did consider continuing the tradition of naming the fifth course a color, the course had an obvious character that we felt deserved a name with a deeper connection to the land and its story,” said Blundell. “Several color names were discussed, but ultimately Bone Valley felt far more authentic.”
