STREAMSONG, FLORIDA: The same year Netflix was founded, I launched Executive Cup. My original mission was to allow private club champions from around the country the opportunity to compete for national titles. Over the past two decades, our tournament has traveled across 7,000 miles from the shores of Maui to the beaches of Puerto Vallarta to the famous floating green in Coeur d'Alene, Idaho. The goal has not wavered since day one—to blend competition and camaraderie at some of the finest golf resorts around the world.

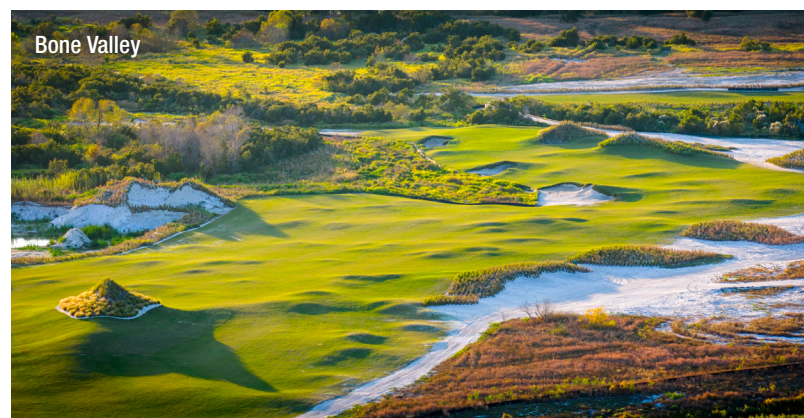
In 2027, Executive Cup moves to Streamsong Resort in central Florida (about a 90-minute drive from Tampa or Orlando). Site of a former phosphate mine, the resort's 16,000 acres are punctuated with dramatic elevation changes, abundant lakes, and 15 million cubic yards of sand—a sharp contrast to the rest of Central Florida's relatively flat topography.

Players will be some of the first in the world to experience the resort's newest course, Bone Valley, designed by David McLay Kidd.

"To be included in a group of architects [Streamsong Red was designed by Bill Coore/Ben Crenshaw, Stream-

song Blue was designed by Tom Doak, and Streamsong Black was designed by Gil Hanse] made me nervous, but in a good way," said Kidd. "My barometer of success is having a foursome sitting at the bar after their round arguing which Streamsong course is better and having some of them insist it is mine. I'm excited to add to the history of a place so young and yet so rooted in a tradition of exceptional golf architecture and service."

After two rounds of play on Bone Valley, Executive Cup will conclude on Streamsong Black. "My site was different than the rest of Streamsong Resort," detailed Hanse. "Welcome to the big ball park is a common refrain. The course offers wide fairways and exceptionally large greens to match its scale. It was a dream come true to see the final product." ►
