TESORO CLUB Watson Returns

This fall, the front nine of the Tom Watson Course reopens, marking the next chapter in its restoration.



Palmer Course

PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA: A quarter mile of raised wooden boardwalk carries the cart path out over the estuary on the Tom Watson Course. Water moves uninterrupted beneath it. Wading birds hold their ground close enough to count. It is the kind of unique hole a golfer describes on the drive home.

Later this fall, the front nine of the Tom Watson Course reopens. It is the next stage of a restoration that began on the Arnold Palmer Course and has helped increase membership at Tesoro Club by almost 40 percent during the last year.

"We started with Palmer. Now the attention turns to Watson," says Tim Jones, co-developer of Tesoro Club. "One thing that the two courses have in common is that each has more than a mile of raised cart paths, so that water can keep moving through our acres of estuaries and on to the St. Lucie River."

bridges, the courses present themselves very differently. "Palmer favors an air game," says Matt Doyle, head golf professional. "Watson has fewer forced carries and rewards an accurate bump-and-run. Five British Opens will do that to a man's design philosophy."

And golf is only part of the rhythm here. Between rounds, there is the Swim and Racquet Club, two restaurants, a spa, salon and fitness center, and a clubhouse built on a scale rarely seen today. But perhaps the better measure of Tesoro Club is what happens after the round: the tables

that keep getting pushed together at dinner, the familiar faces at the bar that wave you over, and the plans made for tomorrow before tonight ends. Home is just a golf cart ride from all of it, with homesites still to be claimed inside the gates. Come rediscover Tesoro Club. ■
